ABOUT SEARCH

SEARCH, The National Consortium for Justice Information and Statistics, is a national nonprofit organization that plays a critical and enduring leadership role in building and supporting criminal history record information (CHRI) systems and information sharing capabilities throughout the nation.

*SEARCH is comprised of Governor-appointed representatives of every state and territory in the nation. SEARCH Members are the directors of the state criminal history records repositories, where they manage CCH and AFIS systems, as well as statewide information sharing capabilities. SEARCH is **the** national venue through which the states articulate their criminal history and justice information sharing and management needs, priorities, policies, and practice.*

SEARCH Members manage large-scale, statewide information systems to support computerized criminal histories (CCH). They also frequently manage their state's automated fingerprint identification system (AFIS), sex offender registry, warrant system, and a host of other mission-critical information resources that support the Interstate Identification Index (III), National Fingerprint File (NFF), National Instant Criminal Background Check System (NICS), and other critical and operationally relevant systems. The SEARCH Membership Group provides operational and policy perspectives to justice information sharing efforts nationally, and supports daily engagement with state and local law enforcement agencies, prosecutors, courts, corrections, and community release programs.

The 2022 SEARCH Annual Membership Group Meeting will convene at the Grand Hyatt Denver in Denver, CO, on July 19–21.
